This funding will be used to

- Increase students achieving 'A-C' standard or higher in English in Year 1 to 6 from 70% to 80%.
- Retain NMS of 70% or above for NAPLAN results for years 3 & 5 in Reading and Writing

Our initiatives include

- Develop teaching capacity through implementing Instructional Coaching Model – Co-Plan / Co-Teach / Co-Reflect
- Monitor Short Term data Cycles to manage students at risk of not meeting school targets in reading – 5 week cycle.
- Provide professional development and coaching to deepen teachers' understandings of the '4 Lesson Sequence': English learning area and provide targeted and scaffolded instruction to secure highly effective Quality Teaching and Learning.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Employ a Support Teacher Aide to work in early years classrooms using Reading Recovery/Phonological Awareness program in Reading approaches to develop early literacy skills: **\$18800**
- Embed the '4 Lesson Sequence of Reading' across Early Years Reading Sessions providing professional development and coaching: **\$1640**
- Research and purchase resources to target the improvement of students at risk of not meeting RA/NQ Indicators: **\$1350**
