## This funding will be used to

- Increase students achieving 'A-C' standard in English in Prep to 6 from 85% to 90% (*including ICP students attaining Personal Goals*).
- Achieve NMS of 75% or above for years 3 and 5 in NAPLAN for Reading and Writing.
- Achieve 50% of Students in U2B in NAPLAN for Reading and Writing in year 3

## Our initiatives include

- Building the capability of all new teaching staff through the Instructional Coaching Cycle model (co-plan, co-teach, co-reflect, co-asses) during the 5 Lesson Sequence, Guided Reading and the explicit instruction of writing (Getting Kids Writing: One sentence at a time).
- Develop, analyse, monitor and track the reading and writing success of students and deliver intervention, differentiation and extension programs focussing on high expectations for all students, especially students on an individual curriculum plan.
- Develop Individual Curriculum Plans with evidence from all staff including specialty staff, focussing on high expectations for identified student.
- Facilitate professional development and coaching with fidelity to deepen new and existing staff members understandings of the 5 Lesson Sequence, Guided Reading and the Explicit Instruction of Writing across all Key Learning Areas to provide whole school clarity and best practice.

## Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Employ support literacy Teacher Aide/s to work across in the early years providing intervention and extension programs to support the literacy skill of students in particular students not meeting RA and LOA indicators: \$18,000
- Develop and implement 'Getting Kids Writing: One sentence at a time' program across all year levels. Through professional development and coaching to deepen all staff capacity \$4,000
- Update support resources: \$2,564
